Recommender must describe how they know the student

Recommender must rank the student on a scale of 1-10 with 10= the best

3. Email transcripts of university courses completed to info@asev-es.org

Unofficial transcripts acceptable

Only send the transcript from most recent academic year of progress

4. Scholarship applicant must be a student member of both ASEV and ASEV-ES to be eligible.
